Subject: Burlington-Winooski: Traffic Alert



Project Update

DATE: February 9, 2024

TRAFFIC ALERT:

Starting on Wednesday, February 14, 2024, workers will be completing a subsurface investigation to gather data for the reconstruction of the Colchester Avenue, Riverside Avenue, Barrett Street and Mill Street intersection. This work consists of borings and pavement cores, to provide an understanding of depths to bedrock, soil properties, and existing pavement conditions.

This work requires lane closures and lane shifts in the vicinity of the intersection. All lanes will remain open on the Burlington-Winooski Bridge. The work will occur from 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM on weekdays and is expected to last 1 to 2 weeks, weather permitting. As a reminder, construction on the intersection and bridge projects will not start until 2027.

The Burlington-Winooski Bridge is located between Burlington and Winooski carrying US Routes 2 and 7 over the Winooski River.



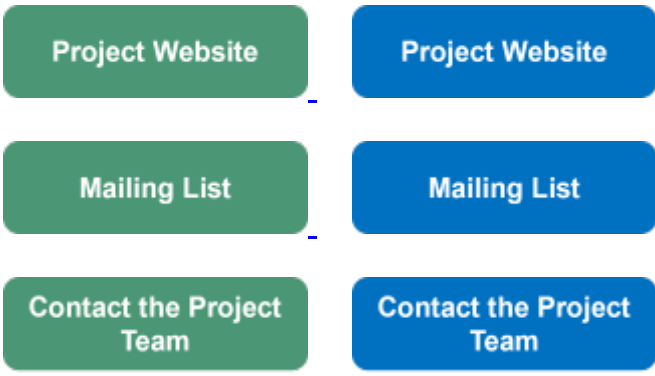
PROJECT SCHEDULE:
