PROJECT UPDATE:

The Burlington City Council will be considering at their Monday April 15th meeting the Finance and Maintenance Agreement for both the Burlington-Winooski Bridge Replacement and Colchester/Barrett/Riverside Intersection Realignment. This action by the Burlington City Council does not commit to the final concept for either project; it also does not change the existing commitments of the City Council. These commitments are replacement of the bridge structure as supported by the preferred alternative in the scoping study and RAISE grant application; and realignment and consolidation of the Colchester/Barrett/Riverside Intersection into a simplified 4-way signalized intersection. The final approved concept is still subject to permitting, public input, and acceptance by the respective communities.
